Dear Prospective Candidate,

Thank you for taking the time to look at our current vacancies. The Ladder School is a pioneering free school, it started its journey many years ago as part of a project between Walsall Studio School and The Vine Trust. The Ladder School project is now being supported through The Mercian Trust, where both other organisations play key roles. The Mercian Trust is a Multi Academy Trust that is made up of a diverse range of schools.

It truly is an exciting time to join The Ladder School, as candidates will be able to help the school embark on its exhilarating journey; we received our first cohort of students in January 2019. The Ladder School fulfils a niche in education within the Walsall area, as the students that are the make-up of the school are those at risk of permanent exclusion from a mainstream setting.

As an Alternative Provision Free School, The Ladder School gives students a second chance. Schools across the Walsall area are able to commission a place for students who might not be able to succeed in their setting. The student will then join The Ladder School, where staff will work on the students social and academic needs to enable them to transform their behaviour and to contribute to society when they leave The Ladder School.

The Ladder School is based at Millennium House (just outside Walsall town centre) where the school currently temporarily based. A brand-new build is set to commence in Spring 2021. Staff and students will be able to see the new school emerge out of the ground that will house state of the art learning facilities to enable young people to succeed.

The Ladder School is projected to have 40 students on roll for the first year ranging from Year Nine to Year Eleven. By the time the school is at capacity (once we move to the new build) the school will have 112 students on roll from Year Nine to Year Thirteen. The Ladder School is one of a small number of Alternative Provision schools that has its own Sixth Form.

The Ladder School will offer a balanced curriculum that focuses on core subjects (English, Maths and Science) that are studied alongside three vocational subjects. Staff with an expertise in supporting or delivering more than one subject are highly desirable candidates for The Ladder School and we encourage you to get in touch!

The Ladder School are looking for staff that have the ability to form excellent relationships with students. The Ladder School will particularly suit staff who have a pastoral background, or those staff who wish to work with students that display



challenging behaviour. Most importantly, we are looking for staff who will thrive working as a close-knit team, who want to be as supportive with colleagues as they are with students.
